CLARIFICATION:

1. Is the water fountain and spigot w/ dog timer part of this contract? I see notes on plans, but no line item on bid form. No. These items will be installed by the City Public Works Department.
2. Is there additional information on the electric service and uplights? No. The electric service will need to be sized for the (2) uplights. The (2) uplights, are not part of this bid package and will be installed by the City at a later date.
3. Is there additional information on the flag pole? (no line item on bid form?) No. The flag pole and 2' stone block wall have been removed from this bid package and will be installed by the City at a later date.
4. Is there additional information on the block wall? (no line item on bid form?) No. The segmental block retaining wall system has been removed from this bid package.
5. Are there any foundations required for the swinging bench (noted as Item 8)? No. The swinging bench is not part of this bid package and will be installed by the City at a later date.
6. For the dog waste station (Note 12), does the post need to be set in concrete? No. The dog waste station is not part of this bid package and will be installed by the City at a later date.

7. Will the trash receptacles require a concrete pad beneath them? No. The trash receptacles are not part of this bid package and will be installed by the City at a later date.
8. For the flagpole base detail, is it to be set in concrete, and should we include, setting the base, and encasing it in concrete? No. The flagpole, 2' stone block wall and (2) uprights (site plan note 5) are not part of this bid package and will be installed by the City at a later date.
