In the best interest of the City in obtaining competitive bids within the Award Threshold, the City is declaring the meeting to be Non-Mandatory. ## **Meeting Summary**

Subject: Bellflower/Meadowbrook Ditch Restoration Project Pre-Bid Meeting

**Date:** 12/30/24

A Pre-Bid meeting was held to answer contractor questions and bring attention to some City of Mentor concerns. Mentor brought attention to the short window in which the trees need brought down and their concern about not damaging home foundations along easement access locations. Trees must be felled by March 15<sup>th</sup>. Winning bidder shall submit a plan for damage risk mitigation between houses. Contractor may use steel plates or alternate approved method to ensure no damage is done to home foundations. Extra attention shall be given to home foundations along easements in pre-construction video.

The following questions were asked by contractors:

-Can we have access to the 40' easement on Sycamore Road?

Yes, Easement Access #11 has been added to sheet 4. Additional fence quantity has been added to bid-form.

-Can we use Mentor owned properties to temporarily store dirt and equipment?

Yes, Mentor owned properties along the ditches may be used as needed by contactor.

-What are the clearing limits?

The clearing limits roughly equal the grading limits. We are restoring the ditch to the original design conditions with the addition of rock channel protection.

-What restrictions are on the delineated wetlands?

No excavated dirt or fill shall be stored in the wetlands.

Contractor may drive in and through the ditch and the wetlands as necessary. Contractor shall restore the delineated areas to previous condition with wetlands seed mix upon completion.

Dear Mr. Swinger:

This pertains to your application for a Department of the Army permit to dredge silt from 1956.2 linear feet of Stream 1a and 2573.8 linear feet of Stream 1b to restore original capacity resulting in temporary impacts to 0.45 acres of Wetland A, 0.01 acres of Wetland B, 0.01 acres of Wetland C, 0.01 acres of Wetland D, and 0.2 acres of Wetland F, with restoration of the wetlands following completion. The project also will install a 176 linear foot long revetment along Stream 1b resulting in the discharge 166.62 cubic yards of Type D stone below the Ordinary High Water Mark in a 3000 square foot area. The project is bordered on the north by Raymond Drive and to the south by Bellflower Road, City of Mentor, Lake County, Ohio. See the attached drawings.

I have evaluated the impacts associated with your proposal and have concluded that they are authorized by the enclosed Nationwide Permits (NWP) 3 and 13 (enclosed) provided that the attached conditions are satisfied.

Verification of the applicability of these NWPs is valid until March 14, 2026 unless the NWPs are modified, suspended, revoked, or the activity complies with any subsequent permit modification. Please note in accordance with 33 CFR part 330.6(b), that if you commence or are under contract to commence an activity in reliance of the permits prior to the date these Nationwide permits expire, are suspended or revoked, or are modified such that the activity no longer complies with the terms and conditions, you have twelve months from the date of permit modification, expiration, or revocation to complete the activity under the present terms and conditions of the permits, unless the permits have been subject to the provisions of discretionary authority.

It is your responsibility to remain informed of changes to the NWP program. A public notice announcing any changes will be issued when they occur and will be available for viewing at our website: http://www.lrb.usace.army.mil/Missions/Regulatory.aspx. Finally, note that if your activity is not undertaken within the defined period or the project specifications have changed,

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you must immediately notify this office to determine the need for further approval or reverification.

In addition to the general conditions attached to the NWPs, your attention is directed to the following Special Conditions which are also appended at the end of the NWP General Conditions:

1. To reduce any potential adverse effects on the federally-endangered Northern long-eared bat (Myotis septentrionalis), federally-endangered Indiana bat (Myotis sodalis), and proposed endangered Tricolored bat (Perimyotis subflavus), trees (woody stems greater than 3 inches diameter breast height) must not be cut between March 16 and November 14 of any year.

This affirmation is limited to the attached NWPs and associated Water Quality Certifications, and does not obviate the need to obtain any other project specific Federal, state, or local authorization.
